CONFIRMATION CLASSES

Summer is winding down, so its time to talk about Confirmation for the 2019-2020 school year. Confirmation is a 2 year program, designed to help young learners dip into the well of the Bible, and Christian thought - with the idea that it will spark a lifelong connection to Christ. We meet with Peace Lutheran Church for this program, and our program meets once a month. Who is eligible for Confirmation? 6th graders thru 12th graders are the right age for confirmation. Some kids are ready at 6th grade, some not until 7th, but a two year program also builds relationship with other young people their age in the church.

If you have a young person ready for Confirmation, won't you please contact the pastor? We begin our meetings in September.

We also have FLY (Faithful Lutheran Youth) which is a fun youth group made up of four local Lutheran churches - St Mark, Christ the Good Shepherd, Peace and Holy Cross. We meet once a month as well, rotating churches and formats. So your young person has two opportunities a month to be with kids like them who are part of a church. This fall, Confirmation is slated to meet Sunday, Sept 8, 12:30 - 2, Sunday October 6, 12:30 - 2, Sunday November 3, 12:30 - 2 and Sunday December 8th, 12:30 - 2. Please make note of these dates as you make plans for Confirmation this fall. Pentecost is on May 31, 2020 - which is the traditional Sunday for the worship service where our Confirmands Affirm their Baptism! It's going to be a good year. - Pastor P+
