Thank You from Family Promise

Throughout the week you provided a home for 4 families: 6 adults and 5 children. The value of your hosting week is **\$9000.32.**

231 Meals were provided for the families at an average cost of \$293.90 per family per week \$1175.60

Lodging cost saved the guest families an average of \$65 per night for a total of \$1820.

If not for your volunteers, the cost of skilled staff to prepare meals and work with families throughout the week would total \$4,779.72 at an expense of \$24.14 per hour.

Pet shelter nights for 1 dog and 2 kitty cats, and 2 Guinea pigs an average of \$35 per night saved the families \$1225

Thank you for the generosity of your time and commitment to serving children. It is touching to witness the volunteers working together to support and share the ministry of the Interfaith Hospitality Network program, and partnering with other faith communities to do so.
