We will be addressing items such as:

- 1. Accurately defining the space, time, and length of use. Ie. Restricting access.
- 2. Number and age of guests allowed.
- 3. Sanitation and cleaning
- 4. Tracking for tracing in the event of an individual testing positive.
- 5. Spacing and use of masks
- 6. Use of restrooms, drinking fountain and other common areas.
- 7. Others to be determined by the group.
