We will meet in the library at 4:55 on Thursday, with the zoom going live at 5.

In person, we will sit 6 feet apart, and I will have a screen with the Zoom participants up for us all to see. My job will partly be to shift the screen around so folks can see you all, too. We have a new microphone that will be used, hoping for better sound quality. Masks are required. When we finish, I will ask us each to sanitize the chair we used for the next use of that space.

We have been going 45 - 55 minutes depending on the conversation!

IMPORTANT - Don't come unless you feel comfortable doing this. I know folks who just aren't equipped for the Zoom study who are missing a chance to study the bible. So, we'll try this a couple times and see if it works, ok?
