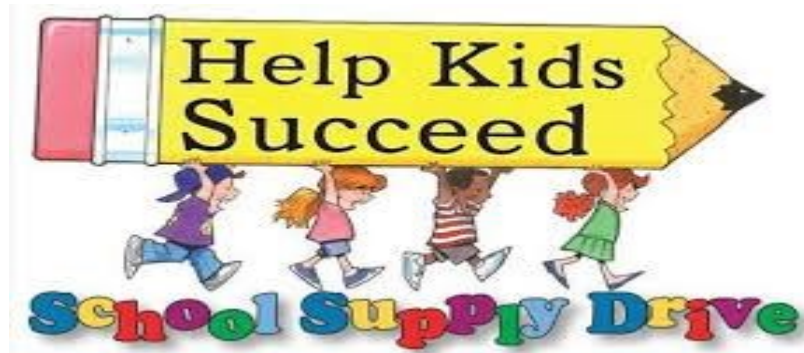



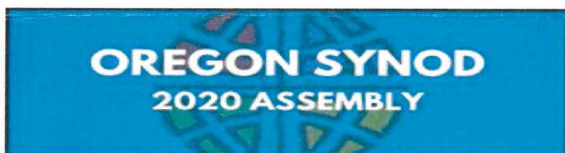


Synod Day of Learning: Liberating our Hidden Stories
