We will also discuss the future mission of Holy Cross together. Between the meetings, council members, and others will write articles for the weekly mailout focusing on the growing edges for our community in the days ahead.

This 'shifting' of elections to March means we will ask current council members to stay on until the new council is installed on May 2, 2021. We owe them a debt of thanks for being willing to be flexible in these Covid days.
