Happy February all. As required by our current church constitution we held our January Annual Meeting this past Sunday, January 31st. We had 34 voting members attending following service in the gym. It was a bit different this year with everyone in masks and raising hands to show their votes rather than saying aye. We reviewed the reports as presented in annual booklet and considered three resolutions that were forwarded to the congregation by your church council.

Resolution #1 was to approve the Proposed Budget for 2021. It has an estimated Income from Operations of \$177,600 and planned Operating Expenses of \$202,350.

Resolution #2 was a request to recess the annual meeting to be reconvened on Sunday, March 14, 2021 so that the Nominating Committee may conclude its work in finding people to fill the expiring terms of your council members and representatives to the Oregon Synod meeting. They will have met electronically a couple of times and expect to have a slate of candidates by the March meeting. Please prayerfully consider if God is asking you to serve in any capacity.

Resolution #3 was an extension of the current council's term of office. To allow for the election of the nominees at the March meeting, the current expiration of February 28, 2021 will be moved to April 30, 2021 and the new council will take office on May 1st.

All resolutions were approved unanimously, and the meeting recessed until March 14, 2021.

During this recess period your council will be presenting some topics each week for you to consider and contacting you for your feedback and opinion. Please take some time to review the annual report booklet and budget and do not hesitate to reach out to me directly with any questions or concerns.
