SUMMER STAFF POSITIONS AT CAMP LUTHERWOOD

• **Cabin Counselor:** The primary responsibility of a counselor is to care for the needs of their campers, creating a safe and engaging environment. Counselors are assigned to a cabin of 8-10 youth whom they lead through the camp schedule. They also plan and participate in activities with campers.

• **Site Support:** This vital staff position plays a key role in maintaining the site and facilities. They help with site projects, join dish crew, and assist counselors when needed.

• **Leadership Team:** Members of this team work with the Program Director to plan and schedule weekly camp activities and serve as mentors for counselors.

• **Kitchen Assistant:** These staff members work with the Head Cook to prepare all of the delicious meals camp enjoys. Experience is preferred, but those willing to learn on-the-job are encouraged to apply.

• **Lifeguard**: Lifeguards are responsible for the safety of all participants in and around the pool. Primary responsibilities include cleaning and maintaining the camp pool, as well as life guarding the pool and lakefront activities. Secondary duties will include assisting on dish crew, camp activities, and camp cleaning. Applicants must have a current lifeguard certificate.

• **Nurse:** The camp nurse will gain hands-on experience helping kids every day! Duties range from administering campers' medications to putting on bandaids. Applicants must be in nursing school or RN certified.

• **Crafts Leader:** This staffer is responsible for planning and leading daily craft projects with campers of all ages. This position requires creativity, various experience, and ability to instruct people of all ages. Secondary responsibilities may include assisting on dish crew, camp activities, and camp cleaning.

Naturalist: The camp Naturalist teaches daily interactive sessions about Lutherwood's environment and God's creation. Ideal applicants have a background and interest in environmental education. Secondary duties may include assisting on dish crew, camp activities, and camp cleaning.
