# **Presidents Letter**

To: Fellow members and friends of Holy Cross Lutheran Church

October 24, 2023

Talking with friends today I realized that it has been some time since I have communicated with many of you. I know that if you're not involved in the daily operation and flow of information it might seem like very little is happening. I assure you that is not the case. I would like to update you on our progress.

- The Transformation Core Team, Margo Jensen, Wendy Smith and Pastor Sena have met and presented a joint decision-making process at the last Council meeting. It was adopted.
- Chuck Palmquist was elected as the Joint Council Chair. He will conduct the discernment and transformation business while Heidi Pramuk, Cindy Spicer and I will continue to direct our separate council business.
- The Joint Council meets the 3<sup>rd</sup> Tuesday of each month prior to our individual Council meetings. The officers of both congregations are meeting informally. Faith in Action is meeting monthly with the Outreach Committee of Christ the Good Shepherd.
- Altar Guild and Altar Care have met and are working together to prepare the altars at both sites. A combined group interested in music is in the formation stages. Contact Pastor or me if you would like to be a part of this group. We are looking for someone to organize the group.
- We have scheduled a joint congregational gathering for after service on Dec. 3 at Holy Cross. This meeting will be conducted by the presidents and Core Team. The intent is to present the survey results and give you, the members, an opportunity to have input into the process.

Please note the deliberate use of "Transformation" not "Transition". I don't know where this process will take us, but believe 2 things about where we are headed:

- 1) What we end up being will not look like the current Holy Cross or Christ the Good Shepherd. The end result will and must be something different than what we are now to survive in a different and changing world. Thus "Transformation".
- 2) We will be better together!!!

The Council and Core Team may be leading, but we are all in this together. Your part is to stay informed and make your thoughts and ideas known. Please read the Council topics and notes (on the bulletin board and in the Blast), attend the congregational gatherings, remember that both Pastor and I are available to you by phone or in person, and Council meetings are open to any of you. If you would like to address the Council, please let me know in advance and I'll put you first on the agenda. No notice needed to sit and listen.

Let's continue to work together towards whatever God has in stores for us.
